

Local Law #3 of the year 2001  
 ADDITIONAL FEE FOR DOG LICENSES  
 Section 10, Article 7, N.Y.S. Agriculture and Markets Law  
 Town of Hunter Town Board

A) [ 4/17/01 by L.L. No. 3-2001] Pursuant to Section 110 of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York, the following annual license fees are hereby established for all dogs within the Town of Hunter:

<u>Type</u>	<u>State Fee</u>	<u>Local Fee</u>	<u>Total</u>
Spayed Female	\$2.50	\$3.00	\$5.50
Unspayed Female	\$7.50	\$10.00	\$17.50
Neutered Male	\$2.50	\$3.00	\$5.50
Unneutered Male	\$7.50	\$10.00	\$17.50

B) At any time during the period of redemption the owner of any dog seized may redeem such dog, provided that such owner produced proof that the dog has been licensed and has been identified, and provided further that the owner pays the following redemption fees:

<u>Number of times impounded</u>	<u>Fee</u>
First.....	\$20.00
Second, within 1 year of the First .....	\$40.00
Third, or more within 1 year of the First .....	\$60.00

C) The additional fees imposed by Section A and Section B of this Local Law shall be the property of the Town of Hunter and shall be used only for controlling dogs and enforcing Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law.

D) This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State's Office.
