Minutes of the April 7th, 2015 meeting were approved.**

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR- offered but no one to speak.

OLD BUSINESS:

1)Mountain Brook Site Plan Review –Tannersville – Public hearing was held at the start of the meeting, no one chose to speak and the hearing was closed. T. Maul presenting addition of private home on commercial property.

Proposed: A 2 story single family dwelling (3 bedroom plus toy/spare room, 2.5 bath and kitchen) approx. 28’ x 44’ on the westerly side of the property with a small private drive off of the parking area of the Inn. The dwelling will have 4 foot footings and will be approximately 35 feet off (or east) of the HTC School property

and 25' from the north side of the property. The building will be cedar shake keeping all aspects of the building complimentary to the Inn.

S. Killourhy states the application was sent to the Greene County Planning Board for 239 Review and received approval. T. Maul states he has received preliminary approval from the Village of Tannersville for water hook up and awaits final approval. He indicates the NYC DEP has met with his contractor, Jim Wiltse and has received preliminary approval for additional connection to the sewer. The Board reviews the SEQRA short EAF.

MOTION: by M. Czermerys for a SEQRA Negative Declaration. Seconded by C. Knopp. Unanimously carried. (S. Schneider absent/recused) The Board notes that once approved the applicant is still responsible for getting final approvals from the Village of Tannersville and the NYCDEP and to get apply for a building permit with the Town of Hunter Building inspector. **MOTION: by J. Dixon for Site Plan approval. Seconded by S. Friedman. Unanimously carried. (S. Schneider absent/recused)**

2) Cortina Mtn Estates Site Plan Review - Haines Falls- Public hearing was held at the start of the meeting, no one chose to speak and the hearing was closed. P. Romano of Chazen and owner D. Baker are in attendance to represent CME. The Board acknowledges the letter/ faxes received from M. Rossmly to P. Romano re: Maintenance and protection of access roads during construction. P. Romano states he has had several conversations with M. Rossmly addressing his concerns regarding guard rails, and the access to his home during construction phases. The Board had also requested to see some type of plan for garbage pickup – specifically in the summer month since bears and other animals can become a nuisance if not maintained properly. S. Killourhy states that some members of the community have pointed out that there is an ad in the Mountain Pennysaver advertising the sale of Cortina Mtn Resort and Estates, saying “also available is approved development land for up to 95 residential units”. S. Killourhy explains the importance to have conditions carry with the site Plan so that there is record of the Boards intensions and any mitigation / protection for neighbors. S. Killourhy states she has spoken with Attorney J. Shaw and he would like to put all the conditions in a resolution, much like what was done for the Subdivision. S. Killourhy explains that will be fine but would also like to see an approval page listing the conditions and the site plan approval/ endorsement box. S. Killourhy explains the Resolution Granting Conditional Final Approval to the CME Subdivision that the Planning Board granted on January 6, 2015 was for 180 days and will expire soon. The Planning Board can grant an extension. S. Killourhy states that in addition to preparing a resolution for Site plan conditional approval, J. Shaw indicated that CME will be seeking that extension at the June meeting.

The Board will review these conditions and discuss any other conditions that seem appropriate to have. S. Killourhy reads some of the conditions that had been discussed in March of 2010. Some of the conditions are:

1. Maintaining open access of Cortina Valley Road during construction, and all roads that are used to access homes. Maintain in good condition so that emergency vehicles can access all homes along Cortina Valley Road and throughout Estates. Construct a Road maintenance agreement to be included in home owner's association agreement.
2. Generator at Wastewater Treatment Plant: Turned away from M. Rossmly's home a scrubber, silent enclosure, wood fencing and hedges to mitigate noise shall be part of the plan. The tests of the generator will be midweek at approximately noon. (approved 2010)
3. Signage: Stop sign at Clum Hill Rd and Cortina Valley Road.

4. Advance notification to all neighbors who would be affected by disruption of service to any / all utility hook-ups.

The Board discusses the main entrance road, Cortina Valley Road (CV Rd.) and its current condition and when construction begins. M. Murin states concern that there will not be enough room on the road (CV Rd) for two cars to pass. The Board discusses and each member agrees to do a site inspection of the Road. The Board will forward comments to J. Shaw for draft resolution to be prepared for the June meeting.
