Supervisor Legg calls the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Representatives from Grant & Lyons are present as they were asked to help the Town craft a solar law that will give the town the review process that the Town Board feels is necessary while still allowing residents to choose solar.

Two types of systems will be discussed

- Residential
- Commercial

Councilman Mahoney states that the Town would be qualified under the adoption of a solar law and the adoption of a unified solar permit from NYSERDA as one of four high impact actions that the Town could take in order to qualify for grant funding. He adds that the Code Enforcement Officer would have to attend solar training which would be another action on the list.

J. Lyons states that the Town of Hunter would want the opportunity for more smaller generation facilities as opposed to larger facilities which would be more of a threat to the aesthetic qualities that the Town of Hunter wishes to protect. He states that net-metering is going away.

He adds that the draft law would recommend Site Plan Review.
