Haines Falls Auto (HFA): The Public Hearing for Haines Falls Auto remains open.

Planning Board has voted unanimously to retain the services of Barton & Loguidice Engineering to assist in the review of the HFA Site Plan and SEQR Lead Agent review of the Site plan and NYS DEC C & D Processing permit. Two (2) contracts have been provided for the Boards review. Upon agreement of the Town Board, an Escrow Account will be established in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the initial review. The applicant will have until January 10th, 2017 to submit fee.

In regard to the Junkyard and Scrap processing permits it is at Town Boards discretion to extend these permits until the January 17^{th} , 2017 meeting with the condition that the escrow account has been established and the Escrow agreement for reimbursement of professional services contract has been signed by all parties. In accordance with the agreement it should be noted that if the escrow account is depleted to or less than 30% of the initial amount (\$1,500.00) the applicant will have 10 business days after notice is given to replenish the account.

Installation of 33' weather station at the terminus of Gillespie Rd on the lands of the NYC DEP. The Board ackn rcv'd revised plan of 33' weather station and revised Full EAF and letter from Dr. Jerry Brotzge stating Mesonet formally has withdrawn the application for placing a 100' tower and a 100' tower will never be considered in the Town of Hunter. Rory France states that he doesn't want to put \$5,000 in escrow and have this board by the end of the Planning Board approval say that they won't issue a variance, so he would pull the whole project and go back to the original pattern of when he got site plan approval for the scale and that would be it until he would know that he would have board approval once the project is approved by the Planning Board. He adds that for him, the whole project is the continuation of the C & D business that was taken away from him with the Scrap Law which is 25% of his business.
