R. Coloton states that he and Dr. Schneider have been talking about Vail's reopening plan for months. He lists the procedures they are currently working on and will follow all NYS and local requirements regarding Covid protection.

- Face masks required for anyone on property (employees and guests)
- Taking social distancing measures
- Capacity limits
- Reservations required -tickets will be sold online only
- Season passholders must also make a reservation
- All retail will be cashless
- Plexiglass screens
- Lift capacity will be limited
- Restaurants will follow all NYS guidelines
- Health screening for employees
- Ski school – reservation only with an at home health check
- Limiting size of lessons
- Summit will be open for restrooms and shelter only
- Cleaning throughout facilities
- Bars will be closed and no televisions
- Socially distant seating in restaurants with 50% capacity
- Removing furniture
- No international employees

Dr. Schneider states that Vail has done a great job and he is confident that they have a safe plan.

R. Coloton adds that this plan is for the entire season.

Councilman Semenza asks if anyone has spoken with the Real Estate Agents about ski rentals.

Councilman Mahoney states that there is very limited real estate available.

Supervisor Legg makes a MOTION to adjourn at 6:48 PM. Seconded by Councilman Semenza.
